Getting Started

- The new site has the same URL as the old one: <u>www.csalliance.org</u>
- Hover over a topic on the main menu and a drop menu will appear showing all that is available under that topic. Click on any subject to see more.
- Members: Although you do not have to log in to use the new website, it is strongly recommended that you do. There are two reasons for this:
 - It will allow you full access to the searchable *Confederate Philatelist*, which should be added to the site in the next few weeks.
 - 2. It will allow you to view and update your profile in the Members Section, although this is a week or so away at this time.
- You should log in using your email address. If you never provided an email address or have difficulty, contact webmaster <u>Mike O'Reilly</u> for assistance.
- When asked for your password, click "Lost Your Password" and then reset your password. You may use your old password when doing this.
