## **Online Dues Renewal with PayPal**

Some members have asked if the Alliance would offer the option to pay dues with PayPal. Now that answer is **YES!** 

- 1. From the <u>CSA website home page</u>, on the top menu bar, click on "**Members**" > "**Membership Renewal**".
- 2. If you are logged in, you will go directly to the "Renew Your Membership" screen,

which has been pre-loaded with the membership rates that you paid in 2019.

- If you want to pay exactly the same dues renewal as 2019, simply click on the "PayPal" button, and then click on "Continue"
- Follow the instructions to connect to PayPal and complete your payment.

# On-the-Road *Half-Day* Course - Napex 2020 Thursday, June 4 - 10 a.m.-1 p.m. McLean, VA

Course Title: Introduction to Confederate States Stamps and Postal History

Instructor: Trish Kaufmann



For those not familiar with On-the-Road courses, put on by the American Philatelic Society, they are generally held in conjunction with shows participating in the World Series of Philately of which Napex is one. It will be held at the show hotel the day before the show opens to the public.

This 3-hour course is geared toward newer Confederate collectors. Cost \$25 to the American Philatelic Society.

The course will present an overview of Confederate States stamps and postal history. There will be hands-on experience identifying stamps which have often-confused designs, such as CSA 11 and CSA 12, as well as introduction to commonly encountered fakes.

If you are an experienced collector, this is likely not the course for you. But if you are new to collecting Confederate stamps and postal history, it may be just the ticket to help you sort out some of the more challenging areas. If you are mentoring a newer collector (or even if you're not), you are most welcome too.
