PREFACE.

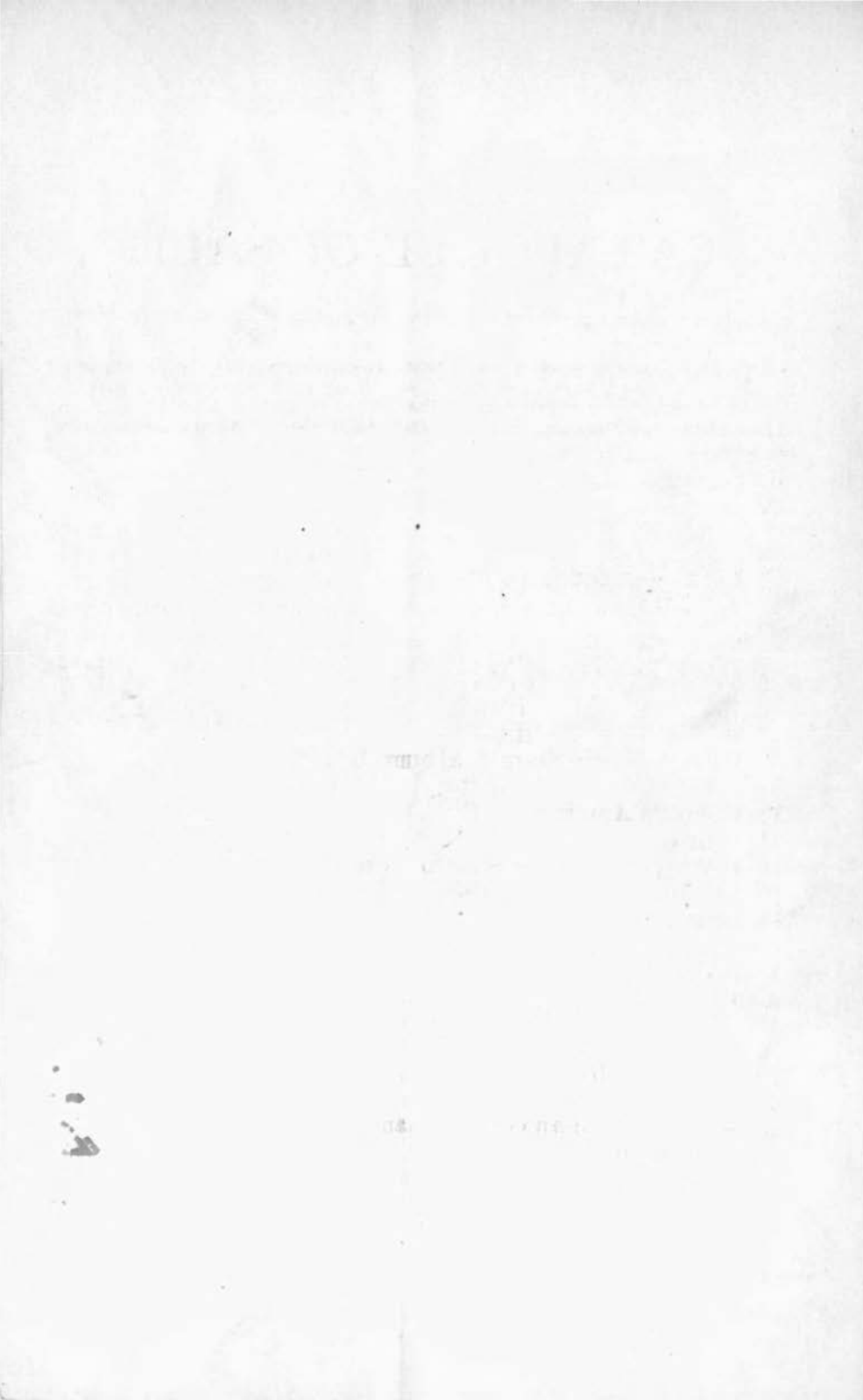
The creditors of a European dealer wishing to dispose of the stock of the Bankrupt, sent them to J. W. Scott & Co., the stamp dealers, 34 Liberty Street, to sell, and they wishing to effect a speedy sale, have adopted this mode of disposing of the goods.

In assorting the stamps for sale, J. W. S. & Co. have endeavored to put the stamps in as small lots as possible to give collectors an opportunity of improving their collections at small cost. This arrangement has crowded out a large quantity of common stamps, which the compilers hope to offer for sale by the same medium in a short time.

Amongst the stamps particularly noticeable for their scarcity may be mentioned the 5 and 10 cent St. Louis, the $\frac{1}{2}$ peso, Peru, the 5 cent Sandwich Island, and many exceedingly scarce proofs and essays.

Several small collections have been added to the sale, which will give novices an opportunity to commence collecting at a small outlay.

A variety of first-class albums all perfectly new will also be found catalogued.
