**Collectors of Postage Stamps** should bear in mind that there are millions of old and valuable Stamps in this country, packed away in garrets or store rooms, and that by finding them they can add many a dollar's worth of good Stamps to their collection at very little or no expense, or else can oftentimes make much cash money.

Please read carefully the following **CONDITIONS** before sending :

The more common varieties should be tied up in packages of 50 or 100. Remember that old or **RARE** Stamps have a higher value if they are on the original envelope, so it is better, in such a case, to send stamp and envelope or letter and all.

All Stamps must be clean ; no torn or heavily cancelled Stamps will be accepted. In all cases it will be best to send the Stamps to us for inspection.

Sufficient 2-cent Stamps must always be enclosed for return postage if the Stamps should not suit us.
