Be sure to always enclose your name and address when sending us stamps, as a letter sent by separate mail does not always enable us to tell who sent the stamps. If you follow instructions you will receive payment promptly by return of mail.

Bear in mind that there are millions of old and valuable stamps packed away among old paper, in garrets and store-rooms—find them and you will find money.

Sufficient two-cent stamps must always be enclosed for return postage.




