Census of the Official Envelopes of the Finance Bureau

Introduction

These censuses include only those covers for which an image was available. Any cover for which no image was found is not included.

Although every effort is made to exclude fake items from the censuses, the inclusion of an item is not a guarantee of authenticity. An authentication service must make that determination.

The color images viewed on a computer screen may not be representative of the actual color.

A census is only as complete as the information available at the time it was compiled. There will always be another item to add to a census. It may not show up this week, or next month, or next year, but at some point, a new item will be discovered to add to the list.

These censuses are different from most censuses compiled in the past because each entry is accompanied by an image of the item, many in color, some in black and white and some only partial. While the image may not be of sufficient resolution or quality to determine a postmark date the features of the item provide the means to tell similar covers apart and to determine if an item is listed or new.

The following explain what is in each census:

Description and Notes illustrates the different types of Finance Bureau envelopes in the census. Additional information may be provided. Also included is a table that contains a count of the envelopes by type.

Census The components of each census are as follows:

Date: The date is obtained either by examination of an image or from descriptions in books, periodicals, exhibits or auction catalogs. Dates are given as "Illegible" when the postmark date cannot be read, as "Unknown" if the postmark is unknown, as "No Postmark" if there is no postmark, and as "Unused" if the envelope is not postally used.

Address: The full address is given as written on the cover with line breaks designated by a slash ("/"). In some cases, the address is taken from an auction description. In such cases the address is in brackets. In other cases, the spelling of a name (person or town) is so poor the correct spelling is given in brackets after the incorrectly spelled word.

Notes: Additional information on the envelope that may not be apparent in the illustration.

Provenance: Provenances are given if the envelope appeared in and was illustrated in a named collection sold at auction, in a book, periodical, an exhibit, or website. A table of all named collections and exhibits can be found in the Provenances Section.

Source: These are the sources of information about individual covers. Sources are given by an abbreviation. The abbreviation is followed by a certificate number for authentication services; a page number or date and page number, if a book or publication or exhibit; and the date, sale number (if known), and lot number, if an auction. If a bound sale has more than one sale number only, only the first sale is listed. When a public source is not available a private source is used. These are identified as "Private collection." Sources are listed in the following order: authentication services, books, journals, exhibits and auction catalogs. Within each group they are arranged in chronological sequence. Color images are indicated by an asterisk after the source. A table of source abbreviations can be found in the Source Abbreviation Section.

Census Number (CN): The number in brackets that follows the last listed source. This number can be useful in identify an individual cover or stamp, particularly for covers with the same date.

Version Number: From time-to-time corrections and additions will be made to the census. These are noted by the version number (v) following the date in the lower left corner of each page. The first census is v1.0 Corrections are indicated by an incremented sub number (v1.1). If a new item is added or an old one removed the basic version number is incremented (v2.0).

To aid the user each census is bookmarked in the left panel. Bookmarks are for the major imprint types only.

Description and Notes

Background

The Act of 13 May 1861 extended the franking privilege to the bureau chiefs and the auditor of the Post Office Department. Consequently, "Official Business" envelopes were printed for the different bureaus and the auditor.

The vast majority of the "official" envelopes were printed on US postal stationary (3c Nesbitt and 3c Star Die envelopes). How did the Confederate Post Office come into possession of a large quantity of US postal stationary?

On 13 May 1861 Postmaster Reagan issued his proclamation announcing the take over the postal service in the Confederate States on 1 June. The proclamation included instructions for all postmasters to render their final accounts for the period up the 31st day of May to the Post Office Department in Washington, D. C. With their accounts they were to submit "all postage stamps and stamped envelopes, remaining on hand, belonging to the Post Office Department of the United States." On 20 May Reagan issued Circular Letter No. 4 which amended the requirement to submit accounts to the Post Office Department in Washington, DC. Instead, they were instructed to retain all postal property in their possession and submit an inventory of same to the Chief of the Appointment Bureau. Thus, by late summer the Confederate Post Office Department had an accurate count of all items of US postage on hand. Realizing the postal stationary could be overprinted for post office use postmasters were directed to send their supplies to the Post Office Department in Richmond.

When were these envelopes were overprinted for official use? Use of printed official commercial envelopes are recorded as early as September 1861. But the earliest use found for overprinted US postal stationary is 1863!

This census of the official envelopes of the Finance Bureau does not follow the listing in the CSA Catalog. Instead, the envelope imprint types comprise the basic listing with the various envelope types and signatures listed under each imprint type. Where there is a CSA Catalog number corresponding to listings in the census they are given.

Historically these envelopes have not attracted much interest. As a result, until very recently when they were illustrated only the imprint area was shown. This makes it more difficult to identify individual covers.

Many of the envelopes have no year dates. In some cases, the year date was determined by using Peter W. W. Powell's *Confederate States of America Markings and Postal History of Richmond, Virginia* (Leonard H. Hartmann, 1987).

On the following pages the different types are illustrated and there is a table of the different types with a count of covers recorded.

The Imprint Types of the Finance Bureau

The top line of all imprints (Confederate States of America) is in an old English font in all types except E and F, which are in a Roman font.

The position of the words shift slightly in some of the imprint types. Thus, the position of "P" in "POST" relative to the line above may vary slightly within a given type. This is due to more than one printing of some of the imprint types. Also, within the same type some of the fonts may be heavier than others.

The major imprint types of the Finance Bureau are illustrated and explained below.


