**The Hallettsville Provisional**

The Hallettsville provisional was prepared by handstamping the office postmark with the date logos replaced by "10 / PAID" on blue ruled paper. The "10 / PAID" was inverted when placed in the postmark.

There is only one recorded example of the Hallettsville provisional and it is on cover.
