## **Rheatown Provisionals**

The Rheatown provisionals were prepared as three typeset settings placed in form to make sheets of three subjects. According to the write up for lot 2275 in Siegel Sale 1104 (24 June 2015) they were printed by Hawes Lea in Knoxville, Tennessee.

The settings are:

Setting A (Position 1) – The border pieces in the top row reverse above the second "E" of "PENCE". The outside border piece to the right of "D" in "PAID" is missing the curved line on the right side.

Setting B (Position 2) - The border pieces in the top row reverse above the second "E" of "PENCE." The right border piece in the top row is inverted with the base up. The inside border piece to the left of "P" in "PAID" is also inverted.


Setting C (Position 3) – The border pieces in the top row reverse between the "N" and "C" of "PENCE." The border piece above the "D" of "PAID" is missing the bottom curved line.

## A Fake that Fooled

The fake

Authentic stamp

At above left is a crude reproduction of a stamp that was illustrated in the 15 January 1872 issue of the English *Philatelical Journal* with a note that the editor believed its authenticity was unquestionable.

At above center is an illustration of a stamp that has some key similarities to the *Philatelical Journal* illustration and is also similar in most details to the authentic stamp from position 1, at above right.

The stamp at the center has been examined by an authentication service twice. Each time it received a good certificate.


However, a close examination of the stamp reveals that it is different from the other Rheatown provisional stamps. The differences are indicative of a fake.

- 1) There is no period after the "M" of "P. M" on the fake.
- 2) The border pieces in the top row reverse above and to the left of the second "E" of "PENCE" on the fake. On the authentic this is directly above the "E." The space between the two balls where the pieces change direction is less on the fake than on the authentic.
- 3) The small diamonds in the outside border pieces around the "PAID / 5" are smaller on the fake than on the authentic.
- 4) On the fake the outside border piece to the right of "D" in "PAID" has a curved line on the right side. This is missing on the authentic stamps.
- 5) "TENN." ends further to the right on the fake than on the authentic.

## The Pair that is No More

The pair illustrated below was cut producing the two singles also illustrated below. The description of lot 3201 in Siegel Sale 1132 (22 June 2016) states it is believed Jack Molesworth cut the pair in the 1980s. The last sale containing the pair is believed to be the John W. Kaufmann Sale of the Beverly Hills Collection on 20 February 1986, lot 59.

The pair is not listed in the census, the two singles are.




