Greenwood Depot Provisional

The Greenwood Depot provisionals were prepared by postmaster James Bruce. He handstamped gray-blue paper with a "PAID" marking multiple times. Then he wrote in ink "Ten Cents" above and signed his name "J Bruce" below the "PAID" marking. These were then cut apart for use.

The 10 October 1887 issue of the *American Philatelist* chronicled the find of the Greenwood Dept provisionals. A group of five covers were found by G. M. Bastable in June of that year. All were addressed to Rev. Paul Whitehead at MacFarland's, Virginia. Since that time one additional cover has been found.

The provisional stamp is not canceled on four of the six covers. The stamp is clearly tied by the town postmark on one cover and just tied on the second.

All covers paid the universal 10-cent rate effective 1 July 1862. Some covers are also docketed with the 1862 year date. For this reason, all are assumed to have been used in 1862.
