The Grove Hill provisional

Little is known of the Grove Hill provisional. It was prepared by engraving the design in wood and then using the single subject to prepare sheets of stamps of undetermined size.

Only two examples are recorded, and both are on cover. A third, off cover example, has been mentioned over the years (Hind, Caspary, Lilly, and Weill Brothers sales). However, no listing or image of this stamp was found while researching this census.
