The Greenville provisionals

The Greenville provisionals were typeset and printed in two colors on glazed paper with a pink tone. The Greenville and Baton Rouge provisionals are credited with being the first bi-color stamps produced in North America.

As far back as 1922 Fred J. Melville credited Judge Benjamin F. Porter with being the postmaster at Greenville and the printer of the Greenville provisionals (*Stamp Lover*, Oct 1922, p. 108). However, the official records of postmaster appointments do not support this. Instead the following two individuals are listed as the postmasters of Greenville during the provisional period.

W. C. Caldwell – holdover from the US period Samuel D. Davis – appointed 8 Aug 1861, in place of Caldwell resigned

Fakes

There are a number of Greenville fake provisionals. Several are illustrated below:



The stamps above are from the Ferrary Sale (Sale 4, Lot 4). Only the center left, and center right stamps are genuine. The two outside stamps are fake.





The covers above bear fake Greenville provisionals tied by fake Greenville postmarks. Note the faker's use of a postmark with the month "SEPT." The Ferrary cover has the same month abbreviation. Almost all towns used a three letter abbreviation for months in their postmarks. On the left cover the date is "15." This is the same date as the cover in the Ferrary image. On the cover at right the "1" was removed. In addition to the suspicious "SEPT" month all the postmarks have an 1861 year date. The authentic Greenville postmark did not have a year date.
