The Livingston provisional

The Livingston provisional is a strikingly attractive stamp that depicts a shield of 11 stars representing the states of the Confederacy. It was lithographed on white wove paper. The layout and sheet size are unknown.

Notes

The Confederate Postmaster

John W. Scott citied Robert F. Houston as the Livingston postmaster at the outbreak of the war(History of the Confederate States Post Office," *American Journal of Philately*, 4:46 (20 October 1871): 118). However, the official appointment records of the U. S. Post Office Department show he was Livingston postmaster from 22 October 1855 to 19 July 1859. He was followed by Stephen W. Murley who was appointed on 12 December 1859.

The Confederate records of postmaster appointments show Murley continued to serve after the takeover of the postal service by the Confederacy on 1 June 1861 and was officially appointed the Confederate postmaster on 31 July 1861. Thus, Murley was the postmaster responsible for the Livingston provisional.
