The Austin, Mississippi, provisional marking was typeset and printed in red on the upper right corner of envelopes. The design lacking any indication of postage paid the word "PAID" was handstamped to the side.

Notes

Early History

In 1945 Stanley Ashbrook wrote that Harold C. Brooks discovered the Austin provisional in 1925. Forty years later F. W. Kressman, Jr. confirmed Brooks discovered the cover in 1925. He also noted he that in the 1950s he wrote the former owner, E. Wulfkuhler, for more information on the cover. Wulfkuhler responded that when the Brooks collection was sold by Stanley Ashbrook he had first choice of the Confederate items and bought the Austin cover. This is where there is confusion. The Brooks collection of Confederates was sold by Laurence & Stryker on 23 April 1943. However, not everything known to be in the Brooks collection was in the sale (including the Austin cover). Some items were sold separately. Perhaps Ashbrook handled some or all of the items that were not included in the auction and that is how Wulfkuhler obtained the Austin cover.
