The Athens Adhesive Provisionals

The Athens adhesives provisionals were prepared as woodcuts. It is debatable if there were one or two woodcuts. If it was a single woodcut of two designs, we must ask why the two designs are not parallel to each other? The margin between the two designs is smaller at the top than at the bottom. On the other hand, the two designs maintain the same irregular margin between the two stamps indicating the two designs were either a single woodcut, two woodcuts glued together, or two woodcuts in a form that never loosened.





A print of the two-subject form (Type A and B) showing the constant margin between the two stamps, narrower at the top than at the bottom.

In the Type A designs the initial "T" is at the 10 o'clock position and in the Type B design the "T" is at the 9 o'clock position. The flattened "8" inside the double oval on the left side of Type A is much longer than the corresponding flattened "8" on the Type B.

The purple stamps were first printed in late September 1861. Then in March 1862 a second printing was made in red. There are noticeable differences between the two printings. Before the second printing was made the woodcut was either cleaned or rubbed against a foreign

surface. Scratches on both types testify to this. The scratches are seen through the letters "ATHE" on the Type A stamp and through "P. M." on the Type B stamp. More noticeable are the scrolls in the four mandrels, which were recut making the colorless design wider.

The form of two subjects used to print the Athens provisionals resulted in several different varieties. First is a horizontal pair showing the stamps as printed from the form of two settings (see illustration on previous page). The stamps were printed in strips of at least six stamps. This required multiple impressions of the form on each strip. This resulted in gutter pairs showing Types B+A as illustrated below. These pairs show a varying gutter width.




At least some of the Athens provisionals were printed by the work-and-turn method where stamps are printed one side of strip of paper and then turned and printed on the other side. This resulted in *tête-bêche* pairs (see illustration below). *Tête-bêche* pairs always show both a Type A and Type B stamp with a varying gutter width..

Athens Stampless Provisional Marking

The Athens stampless PAID 10 marking was also used as a provisional marking. Such uses cannot be distinguished from normal stampless uses except by special features. One of the two recorded examples has the following written on the inside of the top backflap "Andrew had these envelopes stamped & I am obliged to use them or loose the postage" (see illustration below). The second recorded use is an example of the marking not being recognized for postage when mailed at another town – evidence the marking was applied in advance of use.

The 5c red Athens off cover

5c red Athens on cover postmarked 25 Oct [1861] (PF-119314).

The use of the 5c red Athens provisional on the cover above was faked. The 5c red was not issued until March of 1862. Once this was known the stamp was removed. The stamp on cover appeared in an auction as late as April 1983 (Robert A. Siegel, Sale 618, 23 April 1883, lot 283).





Over time collectors and dealers have removed some of the Athens provisionals from covers. The *tête-bêche* purple pair illustrated on the cover at top above was removed sometime after the late 1940s. This example is from the Walcott Collection (Robert Laurence, 23 August 1935, lot 3).

Suspicious Uses

The Athens adhesive provisionals can be a challenge for collectors. Many examples on cover are only canceled, not tied, by light grid markings. It some cases it was determined that the stamp had been moved, did not originate on the cover, or the authentication service declined to give an opinion. Some uses are discussed below.



5c purple (Type B) - postmarked 11 Dec [1861]. The Philatelic Foundation opined the stamp is genuine but did not originate on the cover (certificate 101583). This cover is not included in the census.



5c purple (Type A) – postmarked 21 Dec [1861]. This Cover is similar to the one above. On this cover the stamp was apparently moved to show the 3c star die. Part of a grid cancellation shows below the indicium also indicating a stamp was over the indicia at one time. However, the stamp shows no matching grid at the top or bottom as would be expected. The Philatelic Foundation opined "it is a genuine usage, the cover reduced at right into the indicia" (certificate 529542). This cover is included in the census (CN-014).



5c purple (Type A) – postmarked 13 Dec [1861]. The Civil War Philatelic Authentication Service opined "genuine stamp and cover. Stamp appears to have been moved" (certificate 01827). The Philatelic Foundation opined "the stamp has been removed and replaced on this cover of origin" (certificate 204216). Compare this cover to the two below. This cover is included in the census (CN-017).



5c purple (Type B) postmarked 11 Apr [1862]. The Philatelic Foundation notes state the stamp was genuine but did not originate on the cover (certificate 48480). This cover is not included in the census.



5c purple (Type A) – postmarked 24 J-N [1862]. The Philatelic Foundation declined to give an opinion on this cover (certificate 204217). This cover is not included in the census.






5c purple (Type A) – postmarked 25 Feb [1862]. This cover shows evidence of a heavy grid cancel in the right margin of the stamp, but the grid does not continue onto the cover, why? This cover is included in the census (CN-023).



5c purple (Type B) – postmarked 14 Nov [1861]. The Civil War Authentication Service opined "genuine pen cancel use" (certificate 00338). This is the only recoreded example of an Athens provisional tied on cover by a pen marking. This cover is included in the census (CN-027).



5c purple (Type A) – postmarked 14 Feb [1862]. The Philatelic Foundation notes the stamp is genuine with repairs but declined to give an opinion as to its use on the cover" (certificate 33028). This cover is included in the census (CN-088).



5c purple (Type B) – illegible postmark. The Philatelic Foundation opined "it is a genuine usage on large part of cover which may be missing another stamp" (certificate 279230). However, it appears the stamp is partially over the extreme left portion of the postmark rim. The rim should show on the right stamp margin. On the left side of the stamp the grid smudge ties the stamp. This cover is included in the census (CN-031).



5c purple (Type B) – 14 Nov [1861]. A red "DUE / 5" was added to the cover but for what reason? There is no indication the letter was overweight. Was the cover sent due? Or was the Athens provisional added to the cover? This cover is included in the census (CN-099). (Heritage Auctions, 17 Sep 2016, lot 43804).


