The 2-cent and 5-cent plain and 5c floral border provisionals

The Macon 2-cent, 5-cent plain border, and 5-cent floral border provisionals were typeset. The 5-cent floral border stamp was printed from a setting of 10 subjects arranged in two rows of five. The 5-cent plain border was probably printed from a setting of 10 subjects as well.

Different sources state at least five of the provisionals on cover were printed on laid paper: 21 Jun, 8 Jul, 24 Jul, 27 Jul, and 29 --- (CN 105, 33, 24, 19 and 34). These are not listed separately because the descriptions in different sources are not consistent. However, the descriptions in the census note those covers which some sources list as printed on laid paper.

NOTE: The inclusion of an item in this census is not a guarantee of authenticity.

Notes

Notice on Provisional Stamps

The notice below appeared in the 27 May 1861 edition of the *Macon Daily Telegraph*. The notice states in part that “probably the Postmaster [Dr. Strochecker] will furnish private pre-payment stamps until Government stamps can be procured.” Exactly when the private stamps were available is not known. Although two covers are recorded from early in the first week of June, it is felt the most reliable date is 7 June 1861. See **Notes** on the 5-cent plain border provisional below.

POST OFFICE.—ATTENTION ALL.

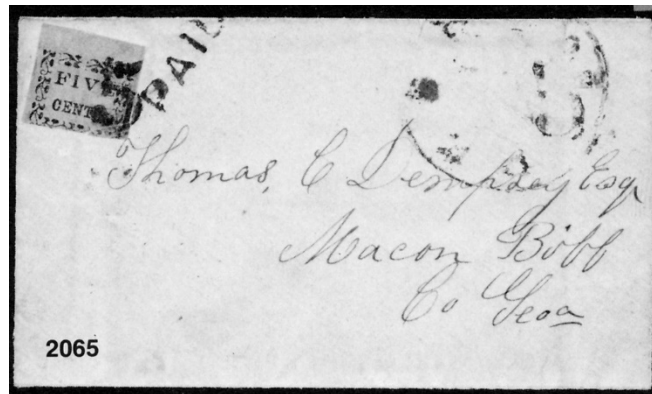
We are requested by Dr. Strochecker to notify all persons receiving newspapers through the Macon Post Office to hand in at once a list of the publications they receive.

The new regulations, under the Confederate States, go into effect the 1st of June; as a full supply of stamps cannot be ready at that time, it will be necessary in mailing letters to send the change with them for pre-payment, as it will be impossible for the office to make change.

Since the foregoing, we have been informed that probably the Postmaster will furnish private pre-payment stamps until Government stamps can be procured.

A Caspary Fake



The cover illustrated above from the Caspary collection (HRH Harmer sale 989) is not included in the census. The postmark is not recognizable as a Macon postmark and the “5” markings do not match any recorded Macon stampless markings. While the stamp may be genuine the use on cover use is not.

Suspicious Plain Border Provisional Covers

These three covers have handstamped Paid 5 markings in addition to the 5-cent adhesive provisional, even though the covers are directed to addresses within the distance for the 5-cent rate. On two of the covers the stamp is not tied or canceled. Curiously, they have the earliest recorded dates of use for this stamp: 1 Jun [1861] (CN-017) and 5 Jun [1861] (CN-005).

On the third cover the stamp is tied (2 --- [186-] (CN 013): However, the "N" of "MACON," which ties the stamp to the cover, appears wider than on other examples of the same postmark indicating the canceled stamp may have been added.

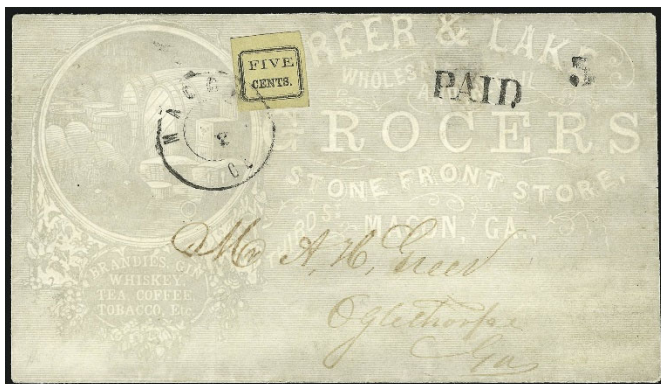

Postmarked 5 Jun [1861] (CN-005)



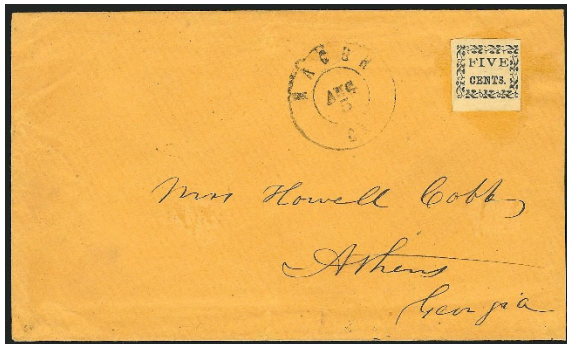

Suspicious Floral Border Provisional Covers

5-Cent Floral Border – On four of the covers the stamp is not tied: 5 Aug [1861] (CN-027); 3 Sep [1861] (CN-039); 20 --- [1861] (CN-023); and no postmark (CN-043). On one of these covers (CN-023) there is a “PAID 5” marking revalued by two strikes of a “PAID 10” marking. It is very unusual for the Macon provisionals not to be tied by the town postmark. The stampless markings would have paid the postage to the destination without the addition of the stamp.

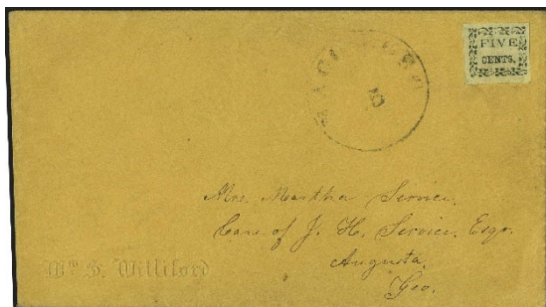
Postmarked 5 Aug [1861] (CN-027)



Postmarked 3 Sep [1861] (CN039)



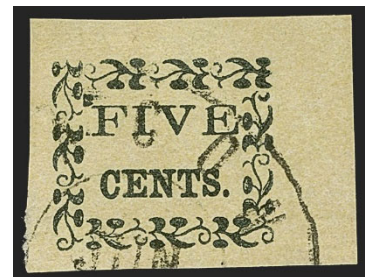
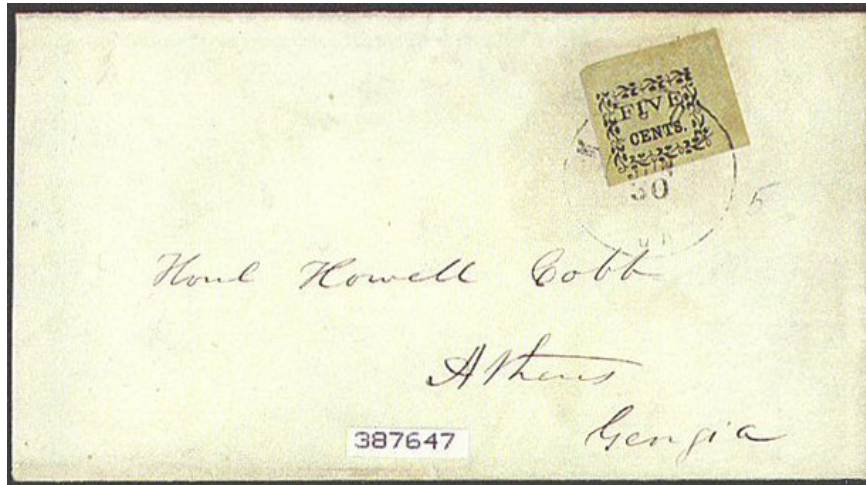

Laid Paper

A number of the floral border stamps are said to be on laid paper: 21 Jun [1861] (CN-025); 30 Jun [1861] (CN-018); 8 Jul [1861] (CN-033); 24 Jul [1861] (CN-024); 27 Jul [1861] (CN-019); and 29 --- [186-] (CN-034). The stamp on CN-018 was determined to be on laid paper when it was lifted from the cover.
