The Forsyth Provisionals

The two types of Forsyth provisionals were prepared as woodcuts and then handstamped on envelopes. All known examples are under postally used stamps.

These markings are most certainly stampless markings and are only considered provisionals when unused, postally used from another town, or under a postally used general issue.
