#### **History**

The earliest mention of the Fincastle provisional was found in the January 1929 *Collectors Club Philatelist* (Lindquist – Reference). The provisional cover was part of a display of Henry C. Needham's Confederate States. The short article mentions the cover was in the Ferrary sale, but it is not mentioned in the index of the sale nor does the front of the cover have Ferrary's trefoil marking in the lower right corner. Two years later there was an article on the Fincastle cover in the March 1931 issue of the *New Southern Philatelist* (Dietz – References). Dietz reiterated what the *Collectors Club Philatelist* mentioned about the Ferrary sale and gave details on the typesetting of the stamp. In addition, it included several sworn affidavits as to the genuineness of the cover. One of the affidavits was from the individual to whom the cover was addressed. All the affidavits were dated in 1901 and 1902.
