The Port Gibson Provisionals

The Port Gibson provisionals were prepared by handstamping envelopes with a "PAID 5" marking. The postmaster, Wm. T. Morris, then signed his name above or below the marking as a control.

Postmaster's Signature

The postmaster's signatures are not exactly alike on the two recorded examples of the provisionals (see below). The most noticeable difference is in the letter "r" in Morris. No example of his handwritten was found for comparison. For lack of any other evidence, it is assumed both signatures are the postmaster's.
