The Weatherford Provisional

The exact method of preparation of the Weatherford provisional is not known. It is suspected it was engraved in wood and printers type added in the four corners to make the word "PAID." The device was then used to handstamp envelopes. Others believe the device was fitted in form and the envelopes printed.

There is no recorded example of a single strike of this provisional on cover.

NOTE: The inclusion of an item in this census is not a guarantee of authenticity.

Notes

History

The Weatherford provisional was first mentioned in an article in 1931 (Dietz – Reference). It was submitted to Dietz by Royden V. Rice of Chicago along with several other covers. The Weatherford cover caught Dietz's attention and he felt it might be a provisional though he did not make that conclusion at the time. It was not until the 1945 edition of the Dietz Catalog that the Weatherford cover was included as a provisional.
