pasted over it General Issue 1861 10c
blue (201), and this is cancelled "Albany
Ga, Mar 15, 1862", the stamp had been
cut off but has been replaced, the cover
is addressed to the Hon. A. H. Stevens,
the Vice-President of the Confederacy,
very fine, very rare.

- 296 ★ 5c dull purple (2), margins small but design intact, fine, rare.
- 297 ○ 5c dull purple (2), lightly cancelled, very large margins on all 4 sides, a remarkably fine copy 40 00
- 298 ○ 5c dull purple (2), used on original, the stamp lightly cancelled, close on all sides, and slightly cut into at the bottom 40 00
- 299 ○ 5c dull purple (2), horizontal pair, showing both types used on cover to Richmond, the pair lightly cancelled, fine margins at sides, close top and bottom, very rare pair 80 00
- 300 ○ 5c red (3), lightly cancelled, wonderfully fine copy of this great rarity, used on cover from Athens to Macon, one of the gems of the collection.

- 301 ○ Envelope 5c black on buff (4), the entire envelope lightly cancelled "Atlanta Ga Nov 15, 1861", very fine, rare.
- 302 ○ 5c black on brownish buff (5), the entire envelope lightly cancelled "Atlanta Ga Oct 25, 1861", very fine, rare.
- 303 ○ 5c black on amber (6), the entire envelope, cancelled "Atlanta Ga Aug 2, 1861", very fine, rare.
- 304 ○ 5c black on orange (7), the entire envelope, lightly cancelled "Atlanta Ga Nov 1, 1861", very fine, rare.
- 305 ○ 5c black on blue (8), the entire envelope, lightly cancelled "Atlanta Jun 24 1861", very fine, rare.
- 306 ○ 5c black on white, not catalogued, should be (8a), cancelled "Atlanta Dec 9, 1861", the envelope slightly damaged in opening, rare.

- 307 ⊙ 5c black on amber (9), has pasted over it 1861 10c blue (201), which is cancelled "March 11, 1862". The provisional has been cut out and replaced; the cover addressed to A. H. Stevens, very fine, very rare.
- 308 ⊙ 10c black on white (10), the entire envelope, pasted over the Provisional is the 10c blue (201), which has been cancelled, very fine, very rare.
- 309 ⊙ 10c black on amber (10a), the entire envelope lightly cancelled "Atlanta Ga Sept 7, 1861", fine, very rare.

Autaugaville.

- 310 ⊙ Envelope 5c black on white (12b), the entire envelope which bears cancellation "Autaugaville Ala Nov 21", the envelope creased and somewhat soiled but of the greatest rarity.

Baton Rouge.

- 311 ⊙ 2c green (13), lightly cancelled in black "PAID", fine margins on all 4 sides, a wonderfully fine copy of this very rare stamp which is wrongly priced in the catalogue.
- 312 ★ 2c green error "Mc Cermick" (13a), margins small but design intact except at the bottom where it is slightly cut into, a really fine copy of this great rarity and one of the gems of the collection.
- 313 ⊙ 5c green and carmine (14), used on original, very fine
- 314 ⊙ 5c green and carmine, error "Mc Cermick" (14a), lightly cancelled in black, good margins but has minute thin spot, very rare.

- 315 ☉ 10c pink (18), used on original, the stamp pen cancelled and very fine though close at lower right, the envelope cancelled "Beaumont Jul 7", a very rare cover.

Danville.

- 341 ○ 5c red (34), used on original, the stamp pen cancelled and the design slightly cut into at top and lower left, the cover fine and very rare

Confederate States.

- 342 ☉ Envelope 5c black on buff (37), the entire envelope, not cancelled but evidently used, trifle defective at left where it has been opened, very rare 100 00

Goliad.

- 343 ☉ 5c gray (47), lightly pen cancelled, slightly defective at lower left corner but a very satisfactory copy of this very rare stamp.
 344 ☉ 10c gray (48), lightly cancelled in black, fine margins on all 4 sides, slightly thin but a remarkably fine copy of this very rare stamp.
 345 ☉ 10c dark blue (50), lightly pen cancelled, fine margins, but the face slightly rubbed and the stamp has been creased. A great rarity in any condition.

Greenwood.

- 346 10c black on gray blue (53), used on original but the stamp not cancelled, the cover cancelled "Greenwood Sept 21", a very fine and very rare cover.

Jonesboro.

- 347 ☉ Envelope 5c black on white (58), the entire envelope, lightly cancelled in blue, very fine, a great rarity, said to be unique.
 348 ☉ — 5c dark blue on orange (60), the entire envelope, not cancelled, very fine, very rare.
 349 ☉ — 5c dark blue on yellow (61), the entire envelope, lightly cancelled in black, very fine, very rare.

Knoxville.

- 350 ★ 5c brick red (64), from lower left corner of sheet, very fine, very rare.

Confederate States.

- 351 ○ Envelope 5c blue on white (67), the entire envelope, not cancelled, very fine 100 00
- 352 ○ — 5c blue on orange (68), the entire envelope, not cancelled, very fine, very rare.
- 353 ○ — 10c red (68a), cut round, lightly cancelled in black, very fine, a great rarity of which this is said to be the only known copy.
- 354 ○ — 10c red on orange (68b), cut round, lightly cancelled in black, slightly damaged at top, and the outer line cut into at bottom, but this is of no great importance in the case of a great rarity such as this, said to be the only known copy.

Lenoir.

- 355 ○ 5c blue and orange (69), used on original, the stamp lightly pen cancelled, very fine. The cover lightly cancelled in blue 100 00

Lexington.

- 356 ○ Envelope 5c black on orange (70), the entire envelope, cancelled in black "Lexington Miss Oct 3", very fine, a great rarity.

Lynchburg.

- 357 ○ 5c blue (72), used on original, very fine, rare 35 00
- 358 ○ 5c pale blue (72a), horizontal pair, used on original, the stamps lightly cancelled in black, cover and stamps very fine and very rare.
- 359 ○ Envelope 5c black on white (73), the entire envelope not cancelled, very fine, very rare.
- 360 ○ — 5c black on white (73), the entire envelope, not cancelled, very fine, very rare.
- 361 ○ — 5c black on amber (74), the entire envelope lightly cancelled in black, very fine, very rare.

Confederate States.

- 362 ☉ — 5c black on buff (75), the entire envelope, lightly cancelled in black, very fine, very rare.

- 365 ☉ 10c black (85), used on back of original to seal letter from Marion to Lynchburg; on face the letter is cancelled "Marion Va Nov 3" and "Paid 10". The stamp used as a seal on the back, is pen cancelled but was damaged when the letter was opened, and has been skillfully repaired to make fine appearance; very rare.
