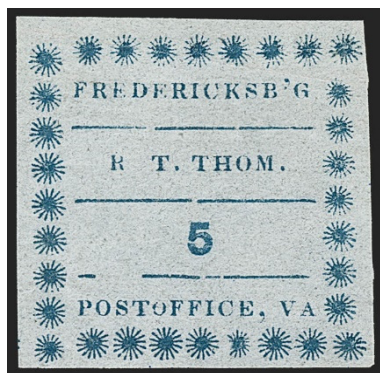

The Fredericksburg Provisionals

Both the 5-cent and 10-cent Fredericksburg provisionals were typeset and printed on thin blue paper. The printing form consisted of two horizontal rows of five subjects each. Two impressions of the printing form were made on each printed sheet.

The 10-cent stamp was prepared by changing the denomination value in each subject of the printing form. **There are no recorded 10-cent provisionals authentically used on cover.**

NOTE: The inclusion of an item in this census is not a guarantee of authenticity.

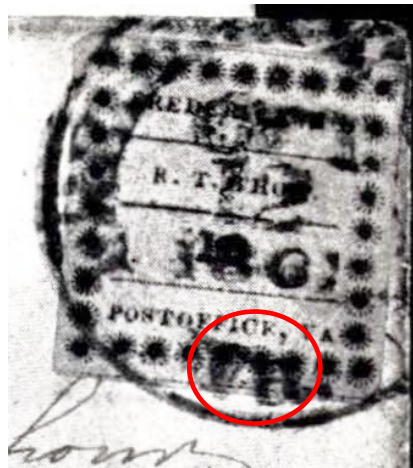

Fakes

The most common Fredericksburg fakes are covers with a fake postmark tying the provisional. The partial image of a cover below is an example. Fredericksburg did not use a postmark with a lower case "a" in the state abbreviation during the war.

A second example of this postmark used to cancel a Fredericksburg provisional on cover is in the Tapling Collection (see
