The Oxford Provisional

The Oxford provisional was prepared by handstamp envelopes with a "PAID 10" marking in a segmented circle. The same marking was used to mark stampless covers.

WARNING: This marking was also used on stampless covers. It is a provisional only when unused, postally used under a general issue, or postally used from another town.

NOTE: The inclusion of an item in this census is not a guarantee of authenticity.
