Spartanburg Stampless Provisionals

John A. Lee was the sole postmaster of Spartanburg during the Civil War. He prepared both adhesive and stampless provisionalsy. The adhesives were prepared by handstamping the undated postmark on pieces of paper and then handstamping the value inside the postmark. All known adhesive provisionals either have no value or the value "5." Since these provisionals were circular in shape most were cut to shape before use. Four types of paper were used to prepare the adhesive provisionals: white, white with light blue ruled lines, bluish with light blue ruled lines, and brown.

The adhesives were canceled by a "PAID" marking. Normally only one strike of the marking tied the stamp but sometimes two strikes of the marking were applied.

The stampless provisionals were prepared by handstamping a "PAID" and a circled "10" on envelopes. The reverse of the envelopes were handstamped with an undated Spartanburg double circle postmark as a control.

The same handstamped markings used to prepare postal stationery provisionals were used as stampless markings. The only difference is the control marking on the reverse of provisionals covers.





### **Ruled Lines**








