The Abingdon provisional markings

The Abingdon provisionals were typeset in three values (2c, 5c, 10c). Envelopes were then handstamped with the devices. The 10-cent value may have used the same border setting, but the rest was reset using different fonts.

Caution: Two of the Abingdon covers in the census have charge box markings.

NOTE: The inclusion of an item in this census is not a guarantee of authenticity.

A Fake Use

The cover illustrated below bears a cut square of the Abingdon provisional marking that was cut from an envelope. Apparently, the faker added the cut square to indicate the postage on a double rate letter.
