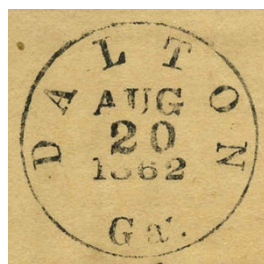

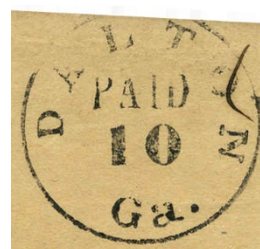
The Dalton Provisionals

The Dalton provisionals were prepared by taking an unused office postmark and inserting "PAID" and the rate ("5" or "10") in place of the date logos. However, the 5-cent and 10-cent markings were not used simultaneously. The 5-cent marking was used until 1 July 1862 after which time the rate in the marking was changed to 10. Before 1 July 1862 the 5-cent marking was revalued in manuscript to make a 10-cent provisional

The postmark used for the provisional markings is similar to the postmark but not the same, as seen in the images below. In the postmark the "a" of "Ga." is small compared to the corresponding "a" in the provisional marking. The "N" of "DALTON" is also larger in the provisional marking.

Notes

Charge Box Markings

Provisional covers with charge box markings are problematic because the notation was usually applied to stampless covers indicating the postage was charged to the account of an individual or business. Such a marking a Confederate cover may mean it was not purchased in advance, but the postage was paid or charged when mailed.

There is no consensus on whether a provisional cover with a charge box marking is, or is not, a provisional. Information on charge box markings is presented to allow the collector to make his own conclusion. For information on both sides of this issue see Crown, and Roth and Kimbrough in 'References' below.

Thirty percent of Dalton provisional covers bear charge box markings. The table below lists these.

Some covers with charge box markings may not be listed because only partial images of some covers were available.

Folded Letters

Folded letters are also problematic. The question centers on how a provisional marking was applied to folded letter? Were they pre-folded before the application of a provisional marking or was a complete letter sheet brought to a post office to have the provisional marking applied? There is no consensus on whether a folded letter with a provisional marking is, or is not, a provisional. The individual collector must make his own conclusion.

There are three Dalton folded letters with provisional markings. There are two additional folded letters that have both provisional markings and charge box markings.

Dalton Provisional Markings Multiuse Markings?

The stampless section of the 2012 CSA Catalog lists circled PAID / 5 and PAID / 10 markings for Dalton, both of which are indicated as legacy listings. During the preparation of the CSA Catalog Confederate examples of neither were found. Thus, there is the possibility that the markings may be prewar, or if Confederate, rarely used. Unless Confederate uses of these stampless markings can be found the Dalton provisional markings may have been multiuse markings used as both stampless markings and provisional markings.

Apparently the provisional marking was accidentally used to cancel the pair of stamps. This cover is not included in the census.
