

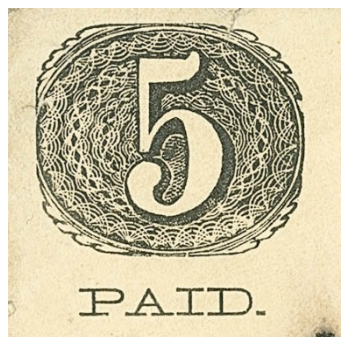

The Lynchburg Provisionals

The Lynchburg adhesive provisional was engraved in wood and reproduced as stereotypes or electrotypes from which a plate of multiple subjects was prepared. The stamp was printed on white wove paper in several shades of blue.

The Lynchburg postal stationery was printed using a stock cut with a large "5" surrounded by a lathe cut background. The word "PAID" was added below in printer's type.

Notes

Uncancelled Adhesive Provisionals on Cover

Three of the adhesive provisionals on cover are not tied by a postmark. These are: CN-004 (29 Aug 1861), CN-006 (4 Sep 1861), and CN-009 (28 Sep 1861). On CN-006 the postmark just misses tying the stamp at upper right. This can be attributed to the poor aim of the clerk who canceled the letter. On the other two covers the stamp is in the upper left and the postmark in the upper right. This can be attributed to the clerk cancelling all mail in the upper right out of habit.

The Woodson Covers – Caveat Emptor

Five of the 5c entire covers are addressed to various individuals by the name of Woodson. None of these covers bear postmarks. This is unusual because the other 16 entires bear postmarks. It is also interesting that four of the bogus 10c Red Danville provisional envelopes also bear addresses to the same individuals by the name of Woodson. The Woodson covers are problematic but included in this census.

The indicia on the Woodson covers are authentic indicating that someone obtained some unused entires or reprints and addressed them with the Woodson names.

Fakes

There are numerous fakes primarily of the adhesive though there are also fakes of the stampless indicia.

Below is an example of an authentic adhesive. Characteristics of this stamp are listed to the side of the stamp. When examining a stamp, it should be checked for two or more characteristics of the authentic stamp.



There are three stacked colorless elongated ovals in the form of a pyramid in the upper left spandrel. This feature is not found in the other three spandrels.

There is a colorless line in the right side of the flag shadow of the "5". This is not normally seen on fakes.

There is a solid parallelogram between the flag and the top of the bowl of the "5." This is not normally seen on fakes.

There is a diamond in the counter of the "5". This is seen on some fakes.

The ornamentation in the spandrels is more elaborate than in the fakes.

Characteristics

A – No colorless line in flag of the “5”

Diamond to top right of “A” in “PAID” instead of a large parallelogram.

Lower left side is slightly indented.

No diamond in counter of “5”

Colored object between flag shadow and bowel of “5” is not a parallelogram.

B – No colorless line in flag of the “5”

Ornaments in four spandrels are plain

Diamond to top right of “A” in “PAID” instead of a large parallelogram.

The corner oval is missing in the lower right spandrel

Figure between flag shadow and bowel of “5” is not a parallelogram.

C – No colorless line in flag of the “5”

Figure between flag shadow and bowel of “5” is not a parallelogram. It is a thick solid line touching both the bottom of the flag shadow and the top of the bowel of the “5.”

It is strongly suggested that Lynchburg adhesive provisionals be submitted to an authentication service that specializes in Confederates.

Below is an example of the authentic Lynchburg indicium and a fake indicium on the postal stationery.

Fake

The fake has a thin colorless line just to the left of the stem of the “5.” It is known in red and black.

One fake does not have “PAID” below the indicium.

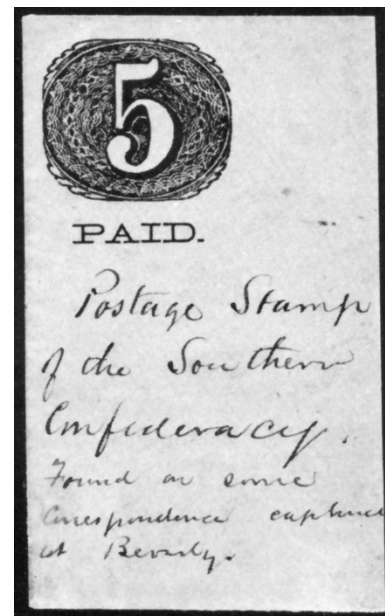
A Curiosity

The left quarter of a piece of postal stationery.

The text reads:

“Postage Stamp of the Southern Confederacy. Found on some correspondence captured at Beverly.”

There was a battle at Rich Mountain just west of Beverly on 11 July 1861 of Beverly. The battle saw the Confederate forces retreat in disorder.

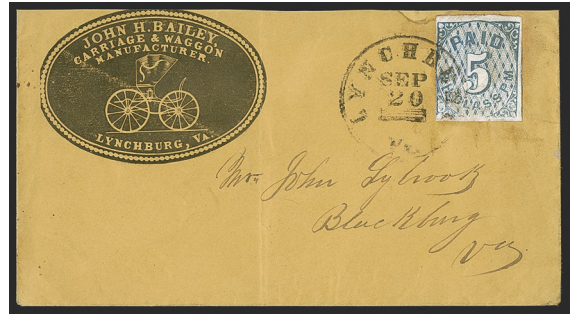
