#### **Cassville Stampless Markings (not to scale)**

The different markings are identified by the 2012 *Confederate States of American* (CSA) *Catalog and Handbook* Stampless Type. The letters "X, Y, and Z," are used to designate added items not in the CSA Catalog. The absence of a CSA Catalog Type in the illustrations above indicates that item is not included in the census.

Items are presented in the census in the order of the illustrations above.

This census is based on images of covers. Only covers for which an image was obtained are listed in the census. For this reason, this census may be far from complete.

**NOTE**: Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the census, but the inclusion of an item is not a guarantee of authenticity.

#### **Post Office Name Change**

According to Confederate and US Post Office Department records the name of the post office was changed from Cassville to Manassas on 19 December 1861. Only days before the State Legislature changed both the town name from Cassville to Manassas and the county name from Cass to Bartow. The reason for the changes was purely political. The previous names, Cassville and Cass County honored Lewis Cass, Secretary of State under President Jackson, who was instrumental in the removal of the Cherokees from northwest Georgia. He was an abolitionist and months after the beginning of the Civil War the names were changed.

Although the name of the post was changed in December people continued to address letters to Cassville as noted in the *Athens* [GA] *Southern Banner* issue of 15 January 1862.

# Change of Name.

It should not be forgotten that the last Legislature changed the name of Cass county to that of Bartow, and Cassville to Manassas. As letters directed to that place are frequently sent to Virginia, they should be directed, Manassas, Bartow County, Georgia.

Letters writers were not the only people slow to make the change. The postmaster, Wm. Latimer, continued to use the Cassville postmark and rate markings until at least the end of February 1862. This may have been due to new bond requirements for the postmaster

When the post office was reestablished after the Civil War, on 25 October 1865, the name was changed back to Cassville.

## Type A Marking



This is a bicolor marking. The "PAID" is blue and the crude circle enclosing the "5" is black. Close examination reveals the "5" was probably written in by pen.
