### Manassas Stampless Marking (not to scale)

The different markings are identified by the 2012 *Confederate States of American (CSA) Catalog and Handbook* Stampless Type. The letters "X, Y, and Z," are used to designate added items not in the CSA Catalog. The absence of a CSA Catalog Type in the illustrations above indicates that item is not included in the census.

Items are presented in the census in the order of the illustrations above.

This census is based on images of covers. Only covers for which an image was obtained are listed in the census. For this reason, this census may be far from complete.

**NOTE:** Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the census, but the inclusion of an item is not a guarantee of authenticity.

## Notes

### Change of Town Name

According to Confederate and US Post Office Department records the name of the post office was changed from Cassville to Manassas on 19 December 1861. The earliest recorded use of the Manassas town postmark in this census is 17 September 1862.

When the post office was reestablished after the Civil War, on 25 October 1865, the name was changed back to Cassville.

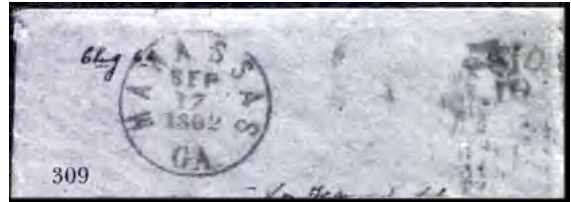

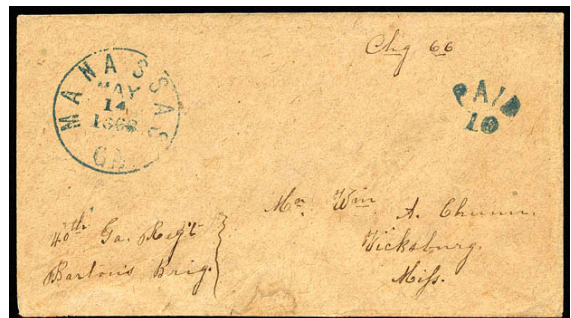
