West Point Stampless Markings (not to scale)

The different markings are identified by the 2012 *Confederate States of American* (CSA) *Catalog and Handbook* Stampless Type. The letters "X, Y, and Z," are used to designate added items not in the CSA Catalog. The absence of a CSA Catalog Type in the illustrations above indicates that item is not included in the census.

Items are presented in the census in the order of the illustrations above.

This census is based on images of covers. Only covers for which an image was obtained are listed in the census. For this reason, this census may be far from complete.

NOTE: Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the census, but the inclusion of an item is not a guarantee of authenticity.

Notes

Unusual Cover

The cover illustrated below shows a strip of 3 of the 2c green general issue used over a 5c Type B marking. One of the 2c stramps is cut diagonally to represent a 1c stamp. Thus, the strip of 2 $1/2 (2 1/2 \times 2) = 5$ for the 5c rate for a letter traveling less than 500 miles. Note the 3 Jun postmark. This would place the use no later than 3 Jun 1862, long before it was common to cut stamps diagonally to represent half the face value of the stamp.

Also note the offset of the PAID 5 marking on the back of one of the 2c stamps. While offsets exist, they are not usually so distinct. This indicates that the stamps were applied over a 5c marking that was just applied.

There is also the question of why were 2c stamps used when the PAID 5 stampless marking would have paid the postage?

This cover is not included in the census.
