CALL FOR CWPS SERVICE AWARDS NOMINATIONS

The CWPS Awards Committee is seeking nominations for the following CWPS service awards, to be presented at the Annual Meeting in Cleveland, in March 2025. The Awards Committee will review all nominations and make their recommendations to the trustees, at whose discretion they will be presented.

August Dietz Award

This award is for “distinguished research and writing in Civil War philately during the past year.” The award is for material not published in the Civil War Philatelist.

Haydn Myer Award

This award is presented at the discretion of the trustees “for distinguished service to the Society by a member during the past year.” A nominee must have made a noteworthy contribution to the Society during the previous year.

Civil War Philatelist Writers Award

This award is for the author of the best article appearing in The Civil War Philatelist since the last annual meeting of the Civil War Philatelic Society. This award includes a \$100 prize.
