# Description



Type A

Halifax Stampless Markings (not to scale)

The different markings are identified by the 2012 Confederate States of American (CSA) Catalog and Handbook Stampless Type. The letters "X, Y, and Z," are used to designate added items not in the CSA Catalog. The absence of a CSA Catalog Type in the illustrations above indicates that item is not included in the census.

Items are presented in the census in the order of the illustrations above.

This census is based on images of covers. Only covers for which an image was obtained are listed in the census. For this reason, this census may be far from complete.

**NOTE**: Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the census, but the inclusion of an item is not a guarantee of authenticity.

#### Legacy Marking

The 2012 CSA Catalog includes as a legacy listing a Type E marking – 5 [due] [not illustrated]. An example of this marking was not found in the preparation of this census.

#### The Halifax Postmark with Year Date

The same Halifax postmark exists both with a year date and without a year date. Use of the year date ceased about April 1863. Although the single postmark produced both markings they are classified as two different types in this census.

#### Is It a Halifax Marking?

The marking on the cover below is listed as a Type G Halifax marking in the 2012 CSA Catalog. But is it really a Halifax marking? The only postal marking on the front of the cover is the Halifax postmark. If the cover was forwarded from Halifax there should be an originating postmark and indication of the rate paid. There is neither.

There is one **speculative** explanation. There were several training camps in the vicinity of Halifax. Was the soldier's letter mailed at Halifax and the postage indicated by the forwarded marking? Additional research is needed to validate the forwarded marking as that of Halifax. For that reason, it is not included in this census.
