
Census of Chapel Hill, Texas, Stampless Markings

Description



Chapel Hill Stampless Markings (not to scale)

The different markings are identified by the 2012 *Confederate States of American* (CSA) *Catalog and Handbook* Stampless Type. The letters "X, Y, and Z," are used to designate added items not in the CSA Catalog.

Only stampless covers with a handstamped marking are included in the census.

This census is based on images of covers. Only covers for which an image was obtained are listed in the census. For this reason, this census may be far from complete.

NOTE: Every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of the census, but the inclusion of an item is not a guarantee of authenticity.

Stampless Paid 5c Uses in June 1861: The last use of a stampless 5c marking in this census is March 1862. It is possible there were also uses in June 1862. Therefore, any 5c use in June must have a dated postmark or other evidence of its year of use.

Notes

Type Ha Cover dated 28 June 1861

The markings on this cover (see below) are somewhat confusing. The destination (Williamston, NC) is over 500 miles from Chapel Hill, as such the cover should have been rated due 10. Instead, there is a Chapel Hill negative "5" due marking. At some point the manuscript "Due 5" was added. Was this to be added to the negative "5" due marking? If so, this was a departure from the norm where the postmaster would add a "5" below the "5" marking and then sum to the two markings to make "10." This is the only Chapel Hill cover with two different due markings.




