**Stampless Paid 5c Uses in June 1861:** The last use of a stampless Paid 5c marking in this census is 25 November 1861. Therefore, any Paid 5c use in June is assumed to be 1861.

### **Union Occupation in Civil War**

By late 1862 Como Depot was under Union control as they consolidated their control over the railroads in northern Mississippi.


