Notes

Civil War Occupation

Natchez surrendered to a Union naval force on 13 May 1862 but was not occupied and the naval force moved on. In anticipation of occupation the postmaster moved stamps, equipment, funds, and records to a safe place. This caused some temporary disruption of mail service.

Natchez's was not formally occupied by Union forces until 13 July 1863.
