

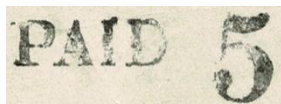

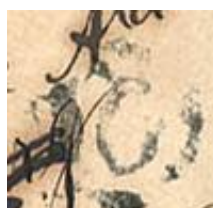

Union Occupation

With the Confederate surrender on 4 July 1863, Vicksburg was occupied by Federal forces.

Type F Marking

Some strikes of this marking show hints of a circle. Some images in the census have arrows pointing this out.

Type X and XX Markings

These markings are probably the same as the circled "10" in the Type C marking. The Type X marking has most of a crude circle and the Type XX has no circle.

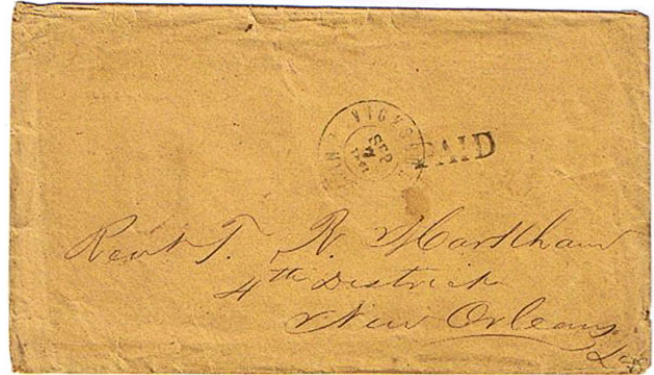
