The Harrisburg Provisionals

The Harrisburg provisionals were prepared by removing the date logos from the office postmark and inserting a “PAID” and a “5” or “10” marking. Envelopes were then handstamped with the device. In the 10c marking only the “1” is legible.

The single 5c and 10c provisional covers are the only recorded examples.

NOTE: The inclusion of an item in this census is not a guarantee of authenticity.

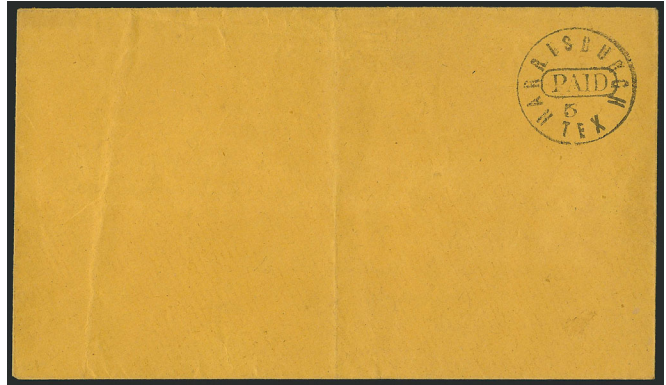
